



Dignity in Dying Bill 2002

Flow chart detailing conditions applicable to assistance in the case of a current request.

Assistance to voluntarily terminate life may not be given.

Euthanasia may be administered in accordance with the express wishes of the patient as far as practicable

* If the person does exhibit symptoms of depression – is of the opinion that treatment for depression, or further treatment, is unlikely to influence the person’s decision to request voluntary euthanasia

Each year the Minister must make a report to Parliament on the administration and operation of the Act.

The Registrar may conduct an inquiry to determine whether information recorded, or proposed to be recorded, in the Register is reliable.
